Strategy 1:

EBLI - EBLI (Evidence-Based Literacy Instruction) is a revolutionary system of literacy

instruction that provides teachers with the research-based theory, skills, concepts,

and practice to effectively and efficiently teach students how to read, write, and

spell correctly from the onset. The multi-modal and highly engaging lessons ensure

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all students are interactively learning in ways that meet their needs. Students quickly learn the English alphabetic code so accurate reading is imprinted.

Spelling patterns are taught in the context of writing and misspelled words are

corrected immediately. Correct writing conventions are modeled and practiced and again, mistakes are corrected as they happen. The results: students learn to read, write, and spell accurately. With this strong foundation in place, teachers
